The Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Inc. as Organising Authority invites entries from the Yachts on the Register of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria or kindred clubs.
The Race will be sailed on Port Phillip under the authority of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Inc.

The Race is to be conducted on Saturday the 31st October 2009 starting at 0930

RULES

All races will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing as amended, the prescriptions and safety regulations of YA, and the PoMC regulations - all as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries shall be accepted from yachts on the Register of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria or Kindred Clubs holding a current Safety Equipment Declaration of Compliance for Category 5

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The safety of the yacht and its crew, including insurance, is the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the yacht. All those taking part in the Race do so at their own risk and responsibility. The organising yacht club is not responsible for the seaworthiness of the yacht whose entry is accepted or for the sufficiency or the adequacy of its equipment.

Attention is drawn to ISAF Rule 4.

A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing.

ENTRIES

Entries should be lodged online with the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions are available from the office of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria.

TROPHIES and PRIZES

The Palliser Trophy shall be awarded to the first boat on the Register of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria. Prizes will be awarded for First, Second and Third places in the race. The prizes will be in accordance with the Royal yacht Club of Victoria's standard Sailing Instructions.
